Exhibitors' and Parents' Agreement. Exhibitor and Parents understand that horse-related activities, especially horse shows, are inherently dangerous. Exhibitor and Parents expressly assume the risks associated with attending and participating in this horse show. In particular, other horses ("horses" includes ponies) may bite, kick, strike, run into or otherwise cause injury or death to Exhibitor and/or Exhibitor's horse. There may be conditions or activities on the show grounds, such as loud noises or running children, that cause Exhibitor's horse and/or other horses to spook, pull back, buck, rear or bolt. Other riders or handlers may be novices and/or may not always exercise adequate control over their horses, particularly in warm-up and gate areas. Exhibitor and Parents understand that this horse show includes jumping activities, which are especially risky – Exhibitor's horse may refuse to jump, spook at the obstacles, knock down the obstacles, become tangled in the obstacles or otherwise harm Exhibitor, itself or others. Exhibitor and Parents understand that no warranty is provided regarding the safety and condition of the show grounds, including trailer parking areas, stalls, warm-up areas, wash racks and competition areas. Accordingly, Exhibitor and Parents agree upon behalf of themselves, their heirs, guardians and legal representatives, not to sue Noel Sewall, Laura Sewall, Windmill Ranch, Irene Lorimer, Steve Randall, or such parties' employees, agents, heirs, successors or assigns or otherwise make a claim against such parties in connection with any injury or death in connection with this horse show.

*To be judged on a course of 8 fences. Riders may be asked by Judge to demonstrate counter canter, extended trot, show lead changes, lengthening of stride, etc.

**This is a team of 2 riders. Teams may dress up the same or wear a costume to represent themselves. They will jump a course individually. The team with the least amount of faults wins a jumper sash.

***All riders will start at the poles. The riders will jump 4 fences set in a cloverleaf pattern. Will be judged on time and faults.

Horseshow Rules

1. Walk/Trot and pole classes will not count towards High Point.
2. All classes entered on day of show shall pay a post entry fee.
3. Classes will be guided by current USEF rules.
4. The age of the exhibitor on December 1 shall be maintained through the next calendar year.
5. Management reserves the right to cancel or combined classes. A minimum of three entries will constitute a class.
6. No dogs are permitted anywhere on the grounds, anytime -- STRICTLY ENFORCED.
7. Keep children under control.
8. It is the intention of the management to avoid holding ring to wait for horses or riders. Therefore, the order will be posted just prior to the class. The next two horses to ride will be announced. Competitors with conflicts must arrange their order with the starter so that they will not hold up a class.
9. All horses must be serviceable sound. The soundness of animals when determined by the judge shall be final and cannot be protested.
10. All riders, whether showing or not, shall wear hard hats and boots. Approved protective headgear must be worn when riding anywhere on the grounds, and junior riders must have chinstraps fastened whenever mounted.
11. Every person riding on show grounds must sign or have a parent or guardian sign a release form.
12. No refunds without veterinarian or doctor's certificate.
13. Maximum entries per show: 70
